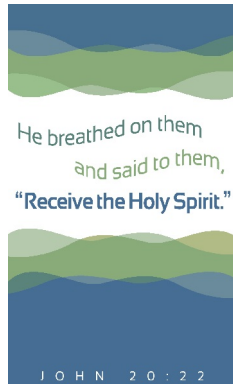

OPEN POSITION -After many years of dedicated service, Marcie Liebl has decided that at the end of June, she will give up her job of cleaning the church. Marcie, Immaculate Conception sincerely appreciates your loyal and responsible work ethic, in keeping our church looking great every week!

That means that we have an opening for someone who would like to take over Marcie's job, effective July 1. The position pays \$12.50 an hour, less taxes and withholding required by the government, and it would be an estimate of 2 hours each week. This should work out to be approximately \$75 a month after deductions. Probably enough to cover a cell phone or cable bill for only 2 hours of work each week, is one way to look at it. Extra hours would occasionally be available for special situations or events like preparation before a funeral and such. The days/times are flexible. The cleaning can be done any time after our Thursday morning Mass, but before Sunday morning Mass. We are looking for someone who is interested in a year-round position, as opposed to a summer-only job.
