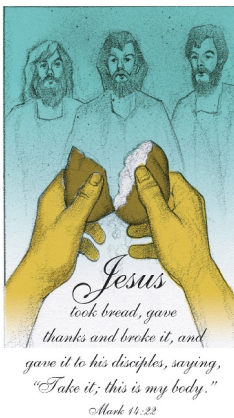

Extra hours would occasionally be available for special situations or events like preparation before a funeral and such. The days/times are flexible. The cleaning can be done any time after our Thursday morning Mass, but before Sunday morning Mass. We are looking for someone who is interested in a year-round position, as opposed to a summer-only job.
