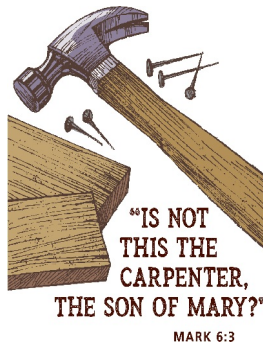

ST. JOSEPH PARISH COUNCIL met on June 24th. Items discussed were the upcoming parish picnic, scheduled for August 12th. Ticket cost will again be \$10 for adults. Also discussed was a workshop on suicide awareness, to be offered by the parish this coming September. It will be open to the general community. Curtis Wolf has completed two terms on the council and will be seeking a replacement. Finally, perceptions of the parish's financial situation were discussed.

If a farmer donates to St. Joseph School, he or she will be asked if they want the proceeds to go directly to the school or to the Endowment or Living Legacy Fund.
