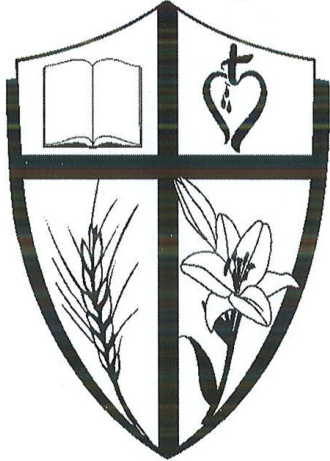

Seven Ways to Support Our Kids Without Spending Additional Money

Here are seven activities, which most folk in our parish can do, to support Saint Joseph School. They all involve purchasing what you already purchase. Please consider each. Even better, ask a friend, neighbor, or relative to do the same. One doesn't need to live in Ellinwood to do many of these. And given our parish deficit, we need the help!

1/ Register St. Joseph School as your designated charity with Dillons.



Sign-in or create an account at

www.dillons.com/community-rewards Select St. Joseph School by name or by number: 11102. The school receives 1% of each dollar spent when you use your Dillons Card. Now, the account doesn't need to be renewed annually. Please encourage all your friends and relatives, especially alumni, to do this.

2/Cut and save "Best Choice" UPC labels on products from Ellinwood Family Foods. We can redeem them for cash.



3/ Shop online at AmazonSmile

The selection and prices, offers and services, are all the same as on Amazon, but if you designate St. Joseph Church in Ellinwood, KS as your charity, a half cent of each dollar spent goes directly to the school. Google "AmazonSmile" to get started.



4/ Cut, save, and submit **boxtops4education**. There's a box for them in the church entrance and at the school.

5/ Purchase scrip for Walmart, Ellinwood Family Foods, and Amazon. Scrip is sold before and after Mass and can also be purchased from Danielle Weber at *Gather* and from Angie Gunn at *Farmers Mutual Insurance*.

You receive scrip for the amount that you pay, but the school earns 3-4% from each dollar of scrip sold. And yes, you can use that scrip online at AmazonSmile.

Twice a year, we have a major sale of scrip that can be used all over the U.S.A. Watch the bulletins.



6/ Purchase gas, using cash or check, at Zips in Ellinwood. 3 cents on every dollar you spend goes to the school.



7/ Save your aluminum cans and deposit them in the blue bins behind the school. We use this money for our athletic fund.
